	Please inform your child's homeroom teacher or the school manager that you would like to submit an application. The kindergarten homeroom teacher will send your child's school report to the elementary school.		
Physician's certificate of health	A certificate stating that the child has no problems with school life is required.		
Birth notification	A copy of the health insurance card or other document that confirms the date Birth notification of your child's birth.		
Photo	Photo data of applicant, Parent/Guardian1 and 2. *(taken within the last three months / a snapshot is not allowed / shows the applicant/parent pictured alone / hat's off)		
	In cases where there are special circumstances, either one of the parents or guardians may be listed. Please note that the parents/guardians listed here will be asked to attend a parents' interview.		

4 Application Procedure

The online application procedure is as follows.

Please note that there may be cases where the email is deemed to be a virus or spam and is not sorted into your inbox, and you may not be able to check the email, or the email itself may not be delivered to you.

- 3. You will receive information about required documents and payment procedures to your registered e-mail address. Please follow the instructions to submit the documents and pay the examination fee.
